Dear Colleague,

I am writing to notify you of a change to the way we treat ARCP outcome 3 time when we issue a CCT.

The GMC has confirmed that: "Where a [doctor] undertakes additional training time in the UK, for any reason (including an ARCP outcome 3), this can contribute to the minimum UK training time required for eligibility for CCT."

This will have no effect on how you use ARCP Outcome 3 to support trainees with extra time to pass exams or meet learning outcomes. However, it may have an effect on CCT dates. If a trainee gets an ARCP 3 early in training and subsequently catches up with exams and LOs, they can now regain the time at the end of training, completing at 48 months.

We will implement this change from 1st November 2020 and start to count training time while a trainee was on an outcome 3 towards the minimum training time. You may wish to review CCTs of trainees near the end of training who have had an Outcome 3 during training. Please let us know if you have any questions.
